



# American Society of Civil Engineers Illinois Section Technical Institutes 2017 Scholarship Instructions

The Technical Institutes of the American Society of Civil Engineers Illinois Section (ISASCE) have established scholarships for students pursuing a course of graduate/undergraduate study in the various fields within civil engineering. A description of each ISASCE Technical Institute scholarship is outlined below. The scholarships will be awarded at the ISACE President-Elect and Student Scholarship Dinner on April 13, 2017 at Maggiano's Little Italy, Chicago, IL.

- The Environmental and Water Resources Institute (EWRI) of the American Society of Civil Engineers, Illinois Section, will award two scholarships of \$2,000 each to a qualified graduate and undergraduate student. Eligible students should be taking elective courses which indicate an interest in environmental engineering and/or water resources engineering.
- The Geo-Institute (GI) of the American Society of Civil Engineers, Illinois Section, will award two scholarships of \$1,500 each to a qualified graduate and undergraduate student. Eligible students should be taking elective courses which indicate an interest in geotechnical engineering, geology, geo-environmental engineering and geo-structural engineering.
- The Transportation & Development Institute (T&DI) will award two Bob Camillone Memorial scholarships of \$2,000 each to a qualified graduate and undergraduate student. Eligible students should be taking elective courses in transportation engineering, drainage, urban planning, structural and geotechnical engineering.
- The Structural Engineering Institute (SEI) of the American Society of Civil Engineers, Illinois Section, will award two scholarships of \$1,000 each to a qualified graduate and undergraduate student. Eligible students should be taking elective courses in structural and architectural engineering.
- The Urban Planning and Development Group (UPDG) will award two scholarships of \$2,000 each to two qualified undergraduates (Sophomore, Junior or Senior standing) enrolled in a civil engineering program.

**ELIGIBILITY.** Candidates must be pursuing an undergraduate/graduate degree in Civil Engineering in a university or college program accredited by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology.

1. The candidate must be enrolled in a civil engineering program at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC), Northwestern University (NU), or the Illinois Institute of Technology (IIT). For SEI scholarship candidates, the candidate may be enrolled in a Civil Engineering or an Architectural Engineering program.
2. Students attending universities other than the three listed above may apply if they have an immediate family member who has been a member in good standing of ASCE for the past five years and is presently a member of the Illinois Section.
3. Scheduled to be a full-time engineering undergraduate or graduate student for the fall 2017 semester or with an expected graduation date after August 2017.
4. The candidate must be a current member of ASCE, Illinois Section or the local student chapter.
5. Scholarship winner must be present at the President-Elect/Student Scholarship Dinner. ASCE will sponsor the student and one guest to attend the event.
6. Previous scholarship recipients are not eligible.

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**CRITERIA FOR AWARD SELECTION.** Candidates will be evaluated by the selection committee on the following basis:

- Academic Performance
- Work experience or involvement in community and other extracurricular activities
- Two Letters of Recommendation
- Essay Response

**APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS.** The application consists of the five items below. Applications that are missing any of these items will not be considered. **All information must be emailed by Friday, March 10, 2017.** Completed applications should be sent to the Illinois Section office as listed below.

1. Completed application form.
2. An updated resume, specifically highlighting extracurricular activities and work experience.
3. A current, unofficial college transcript, indicating area of study, course grades and cumulative GPA.
4. One copy of registered classes for fall 2017 (or summer 2017) semester (or anticipated classes if registration is not yet confirmed).
5. Two letters of recommendation written by a university faculty member, employer/community service supervisor or a licensed professional engineer. The letters should be made out to the specific Technical Institute.
6. All items should be sent via email to [illinoissection@isasce.org](mailto:illinoissection@isasce.org). The subject line should have the LAST NAME of candidate and Technical Institute Abbreviation(s).
